Welcome to Kennedy Way Surgery. We want you to access the healthcare you need - when you need it - so we offer SAME day appointments and telephone consultations to ALL of our patients.

Simply contact the surgery and our receptionists will arrange for your preferred GP to call you back, usually before 5pm. You can even book your telephone slot (depending on availability online on the day (login required)..

GPs start seeing and speaking to patients at 8am. If the GP can deal with your query over the phone, they will - (we don't want to waste your time!) - however if you need a face-toface appointment, it will be arranged directly with you on the same day. After 4pm or when we reach capacity, calls are reserved for emergencies that can't wait until the following day.

To minimise the need to take time off work, we also offer web-bookable extended hour appointments early in the morning from 7:30-8:00am. We also have web bookable routine appointments available daily. Our on-line Prescription service will save you extra time. It's all designed to make your life easier.

You will be registered with a named doctor in the practice to encourage continuity of care, however you can see any of the other doctors. See our website to find out who is consulting when, as this is updated weekly.

TEST RESULTS: Please allow 10 working days before calling for result and if possible ring after 11am when the phone lines are quieter. A doctor will call you if necessary. Never assume 'no news is good news', if you have not heard back about a test, please contact reception.

REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS: Repeat prescriptions are given for regular medication only when agreed with the doctor. Repeats can be ordered by e-mail at:

bnssg.kws.prescriptions@nhs.net, via on-line (you need a login), with your pharmacist, by post, or by coming into the surgery .

The pre-printed form attached to your medication, lists all your repeat medication and unless you use email or the website, you will need it to re-order your next prescription. Simply tick the medication you require and return to your chemist or reception.

Please book a mandatory annual medication review with a doctor or nurse in plenty of time before your next prescription as you are responsible for reordering before you run out. Allow two full working days from request to prescription being signed. Electronic prescribing is our preferred method and easily set up by nominating a chemist. To minimise prescription errors and phone-blocking, prescription requests can not be taken over the phone.

SERVICES:

- Home visits are for those truly housebound or extremely unwell. Call by 11am and be prepared to tell the receptionist the reason you need a doctor's visit so we can prioritise requests. Rounds are made about 1pm. - Practice Nurses can be seen for health checks, dressings, cervical smears, remove of sutures and immunisations along with a variety of long term conditions.

Health Care Assistants are available for blood tests, heart tracings, breathing tests, NHS health checks, support to stop smoking, weight loss referrals, flu vaccinations, B12 injections, frailty assessments and dressings.
Full Family Planning services including contraceptive pills, coils, implants, injections, self-administered injections and emergency contraception.

• Health Visitors are based at West Gate Centre for advice on babies and toddlers. 01454 315355.

- Ante-natal / pregnancy care is provided by the midwives based in the West Gate Centre working in association with Hospital Maternity Units, bookable online. Post-natal and baby checks are done here, 6-8 weeks after delivery.

- Childhood immunisations are offered and encouraged.

- Foreign Travel Vaccinations can be given by the practice nurse (some chargeable). Please research what is needed on: fitfor-

travel.co.uk before making an appointment.
